The Literacy Council wants to promote literacy for all ages. We participate in the Holiday Bookshare Program that provides books to needy children and seniors in Brunswick County. In addition, with sufficient community support, we would like to expand our book donations to other underserved populations.

Last year, we provided 3000 books for children and seniors through the Holiday Bookshare Program, an adjunct to the Brunswick Family Assistance Tree of Hope Project. We collect books year round for this effort and for use with our literacy students.

Book donations should be new or in nearly new conditions.

The kinds of books we need most:

- Children's books for infants through teens. We especially need board books for babies and books appropriate for teens
- Bi-lingual books for children, especially Spanish/English
- New word search or Sudoku books for seniors
- Best sellers: fiction, non-fiction, mystery, science fiction and romance.
- Condensed books

Please note we are unable to accept:

- Books in poor condition, with missing or damaged pages including children's books with crayon marks or missing stickers.
- Encyclopedias
- Record albums, CD's or tapes
- Magazines (including religious tracts)
- Textbooks and Trade manuals
- Religious and political books
